


How to Speed ED Lab Turnaround Time by minutes

Diagnostic labs are performed on 56% of patients in the emergency department (ED).¹ When non-critical lab results are posted to the EHR, it can take upwards of an hour for those results to reach the provider if the provider is not sitting watching the EHR. Delays in turnaround time for non-critical labs contribute to longer lengths of stay and decreased ED throughput.
